

APPROPRIATIONS TIMELINE

SEPTEMBER

Federal Agencies submit proposals to OMB.

OCTOBER

NOVEMBER

Federal Agencies receive “pass back” responses from OMB.

DECEMBER

JANUARY

FEBRUARY

Release of Administration’s Budget Request

MARCH

House and Senate Subcommittees hold Hearings

Member Appropriations Requests Due to Subcommittees

APRIL

Congress should pass an Annual Budget Resolution by April 15.

MAY

JUNE

House begins mark up of bills in subcommittee.

House and Senate work to complete all 12 individual appropriations bills and send to President to be signed into

JULY

AUGUST

SEPTEMBER

Congress must pass a Continuing Resolution for those government operations that do not have a completed appropriations bill.

OCTOBER

Congress will work on the process until all federal funding bills are signed.

Federal Agencies work to develop budget proposals for the next year.
